## Steps To Register

## Levels

### Beginner - JK-SK

Learn the French alphabet, greetings, and how to introduce yourself. Each class includes simple cue cards, memorable French music and short French stories to build understanding to enhance retention.

### Intermediate - Grades 1-3

Learn French phonics to confidently and independently read our French stories. In class activities polish your knowledge of French grammar and sentence structure.

## Why learn French?

French is widely spoken on all five continents. The official languages of Canada are English and French and most schools offer French as a second language. Young learners will also discover French and English complement each other. Learning French will boost your brain and further your understanding of English!

### Option A: Attend once or twice a week

Similar to fall, winter, and spring semesters students can continue their sessions a fixed time
