



In-Person Phonics and Spelling Class

55 minutes per class

Why learn phonics and decoding?

- Phonics is a method for teaching reading and writing that creates an understanding of identifying different sounds made by individual letters and letter groups.
- Decoding is an essential skill for learning to read that develops learners' ability to hear, identify, and manipulate sound patterns. It allows students to figure out most words they've heard but have never seen in print.
- The ability to decode is the foundation upon which all other reading instruction—fluency, vocabulary, reading comprehension, etc. are built.

What are the class levels?

There are 20 beginner lessons where students learn the alphabet, 3-4 letter words, and common sight words.

There are 50 intermediate lessons where students learn blending, digraphs, and reading picture books on their own.

Is there homework for each class?

Each class there is a homework worksheet that is connected to the letters or blends we learned for the class!

Students also take home 4 cue cards per class with sight words and high frequency words.
