Steps To Register

1. Select Option A or Option B
2. Select the days/weeks you wish to attend
3. Choose the class time you wish to attend

Levels

Newbie (Daycare)

Students sharpen their English listening skills and as they absorb new storylines. Take turns identifying animals, colors, shapes, and more!

Beginner (Pre-K)

Build reading comprehension by practicing full sentence answers and great classroom etiquette. Through entertaining and memorable stories, become a passionate reader.

Intermediate (K)

Students begin independent reading and critical thinking. Learn life-long lessons through beautifully illustrated books.

Advanced (Gr 1-2)

With a good mix of true stories, students learn about the world around them while practicing engaging storytelling skills, reading with intonation and expression.

Option A: Attend once or twice a week

Similar to fall, winter, and spring semesters students can continue their sessions a fixed time
